Rights and responsibilities under the OSH Act, the appeals process, recordkeeping, and voluntary protection programs are covered. The course also includes an introduction to OSHA's General Industry standards and an overview of the requirements of the more frequently referenced standards. Participants who successfully complete the course and pass a multiple choice test will become outreach trainers, authorized to conduct both 10 and 30 hour General Industry courses. OSHA's 29 CFR 1910 General Industry Standard (1900-1910.999 and 1910.1000 to end) will be provided Prerequisites: Five years relevant experience in the General Industry safety & health field and completion of the OTI 511 Course. **IMPORTANT:** A prerequisite form must be completed upon registration for class, before the 501 has begun. 2045 – Machinery and Machine Guarding Standards

General CEU's: 2.5

This course familiarizes the student with a wide variety of common machinery, related safety standards, and guarding methods. Guidance is provided with respect to the hazards associated with various kinds of machinery and the control of hazardous energy sources (lockout/tagout). The course presents an approach to machine inspection that enables participants to recognize hazards and applicable standards and provides options to achieve abatement.

Participants will tour a private sector facility with extensive and varied metal working operations. Participants will also be given an opportunity to apply hazard recognition concepts on a site inspection at an operating facility with a variety of machine operations. They will evaluate and document any machinery and machine guarding hazards, and then return to the classroom to research the standards for citation references.

3010 – Excavation, Trenching and Soil Mechanics

The target audience is the small employer, business owner, or manager who would like to obtain information about health hazards found in the workplace. This training is also suitable for employees and employee representatives. Exposure to health hazards continues to be common in spite of advances in control measures and techniques. OSHA's current strategic plan has made a reduction in some specific health hazards such as lead, silica, and ergonomic related injuries a high priority. This course will provide information on the types of health hazards and discuss ways to recognize, evaluate, and control them in the workplace.

7300 – Understanding OSHA's Permit Required Confined Space Standards

General CEU's: .7

The primary objective of this course is to increase the participant's knowledge of OSHA's permit-required confined space (permit space) standard, 29 CFR 1910.146. Areas of instruction include scope and definitions, general requirements, permit space programs, rescue and training. Completion of this course does not fulfill the training requirements contained in 29 CFR 191.146, nor does it certify the student as a "competent person." The target audience is the small employer or a representative (e.g. line supervisor or manager) designated with the responsibility to develop a permit space program.
